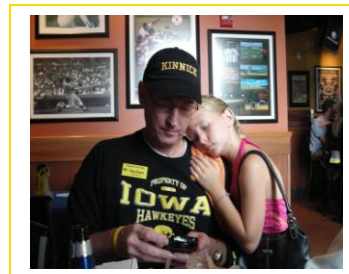
The history of the TBIC

Eddie presented other Iowa Club ideas to all in attendance. Small groups brainstormed ideas in the categories of Membership, Branding, Events, and Website.

After the presentations by the breakout groups, each

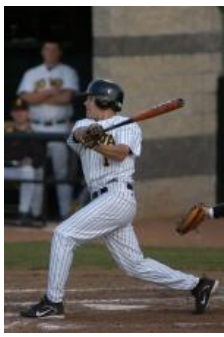

Coach [Jack Dahm](#) and the Hawkeye baseball team opened their 2008 season at the Clearwater Invitational on February 22-24. The games were played at Jack Russell Stadium in Clearwater.

The Hawks won their Friday night game against the University of Albany (NY) Great Danes, 8 to 3. Before Saturday's game

with Notre Dame, the Tampa Bay Iowa Club sponsored a tailgate party with hot dogs and beverages for the 110 prepaid members and 20 family members.

Unfortunately heavy rains delayed the 3 pm game until 8 pm. Not to be deterred the TBIC tailgated at 1 pm & 7 pm for the loyal Hawkeye fans and family members who braved the elements.

Coach Dahm and his assistant coaches were able to visit with the tailgaters as they came off the team bus.

This is Coach Dahm's fifth season as the Hawkeye's Baseball Coach. Last year the Hawks compiled a record 31-23 record, with a fourth place finish in the Big Ten.

Iowa lost to Notre Dame in the bottom of the 10th inning at 12:15 am, 14 to 13.

After very little sleep the Hawkeyes played the Liberty University (VA) Flames at 10 am Sunday and lost 3 to 1 in a close and well played game.

The coaches, players and family appreciated the great turnout and support by the TBIC fans.

alumni together to have fun.

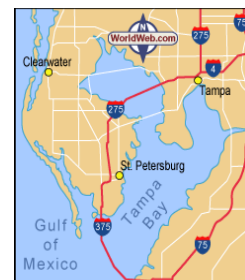
Hawkeye Happy Hours was developed this year in order to find various locations in the Tampa Bay area to allow members to socialize and network.
