5. A TBIC merchandise table is set up and manned just inside the door. All profits also go to the scholarship fund.

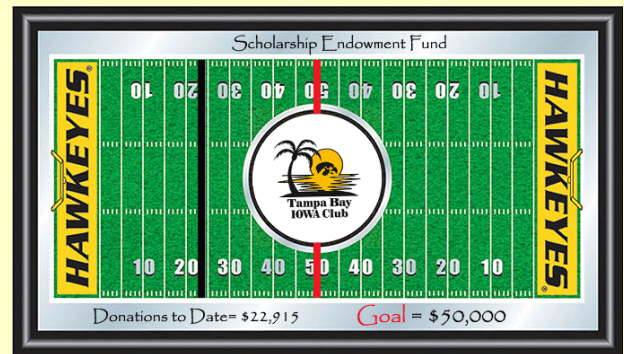
6. Please enjoy yourself but be respectful to the Boston's staff and fellow TBIC'ers in attendance.

Hawkeye Insider – Scott Kennedy

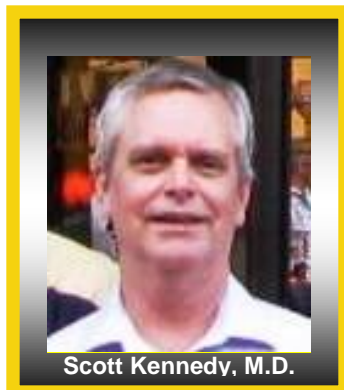
Scott was born and raised in Mason City, Iowa and graduated from [Mason City High School](#) (Go Mohawks!) in 1972. Scott played trumpet in the Mason City H.S. band.

After graduation from high school, he began his studies at the University of Iowa from 1972 – 1979. He earned a Mathematics and General Science B.A. in 1975. He also studied medicine at the University of Iowa Carver School of Medicine and graduated with a Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) in 1979.

From 1979-1982, Dr. Kennedy completed his internship and internal medicine residency at the Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines, IA. He is boarded in Internal Medicine,

Geriatrics, and HIV.

Scott performed the duties of a staff physician at the Iowa Veterans Home, outside of Marshalltown, IA, from 1982-85.



He moved to Florida in 1985 and for the past 18 years has worked for Corizon, the USA's largest contracted provider of medical care to people who are incarcerated in

county jails or state prisons. He started out as a site medical director and advanced to his current management position. Scott is the state medical director for 17 different correctional facilities or so-called medical sites. He manages over 40 doctors, psychiatrists, dentists, nurse practitioners and physician assistants. His activities keep him very busy and he states, "every day at work is an adventure."

Scott has been a member of TBIC for two years and is already a generous supporter (Diamond level) of TBIC's Scholarship Endowment Fund. Work keeps him very busy but he is still able to attend many Tampa Bay IOWA Club activities. Much like all TBIC members, Scott very much enjoys cheering on the Iowa Hawkeyes with fellow Iowans.

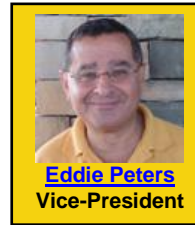
