Ports of Call

KUSADASI, TURKEY

Explore the ruins of ancient Ephesus: the famed Library of Celsus, the amphitheater, chariot-marked marble roads, mosaic sidewalks and the superb, rarely opened Terrace Houses. Or journey to three monumental cities of antiquity – Priene, Miletus and Didyma, renowned for their majestic temples and stadiums.

SANTORINI, GREECE

Visit the beautiful whitewashed hilltop towns of Oia and Fira with their fantastic views. See the stunning artifacts in Fira's museum, including recent finds from the excavation of Akrotiri. Visit a winery and take in the local color.

ZAKYNTHOS, GREECE

The scenic Ionian island is home to medieval churches, archeological sites, famous sea caves and the endangered sea turtle, Caretta-Caretta. The town of Zakynthos has some splendid architecture that exhibits a Venetian influence, especially its fortress and historic Saint Mark's Square.

TAORMINA (SICILY), ITALY

Enjoy panoramic views as you ascend to Taormina where you'll stroll medieval lanes past historic palaces. See the famed Greek Theater and its fantastic view of Mt. Etna. Venture up the volcano itself, where remnants of past eruptions can be seen in cones, craters and lava streams. Discover a Norman Castle built of black lava, and visit beautiful old Catania.

AMALFI/POSITANO, ITALY

Clinging to steep slopes above a sparkling bay, Positano charms all who visit with its white Moorish-style houses and colorful fishing boats. Enchanting Amalfi is filled with ancient wonders like the 12th-century Capuchin monastery and the beautiful 11th-century Cathedral and cloister.

ROME (CIVITAVECCHIA), ITALY

Spend a day reveling in magnificent monuments from the ancient Roman Forum and Colosseum to the splendor of St. Peter's Basilica and Michelangelo's breathtaking frescoes in the Sistine Chapel. Or enjoy a drive through the Roman countryside to lovely, medieval Castel Gandolfo to see the summer residence of the Pope.

FLORENCE/PISA (LIVORNO), ITALY

Explore the fabled architecture of Renaissance Florence: the Duomo with Brunelleschi's dome, the Baptistery, Michelangelo's *David*, the bridge over the Arno and the Uffizi Gallery. Visit Pisa's superb Field of Miracles and the iconic Leaning Tower. Or lose yourself in the Tuscan countryside and the towns of Siena, and San Gimignano renowned for its medieval towers.

MONTE CARLO, MONACO

Take in sparkling Monaco as you drive along the famous Grand Corniche, then stroll through the old quarter. See the pink palace of the Grimaldi family, visit the Casino, explore the Côte d'Azur from Nice to Cannes, Grasse and the lovely St. Paul de Vence, each a jewel to savor.

PROVENCE (MARSEILLE), FRANCE

See the sights and enjoy the views of historic old Marseille and visit the charming fishing port of Cassis. Or venture into the celebrated Provencal countryside and explore lovely Aix or stroll through Avignon and see the Papal Palace, the famed bridge and the hilltop village of Les Baux.

A variety of optional shore excursions featuring highlights of each port of call will be available for an additional charge.
